## PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CLARK COUNTY/VANCOUVER CONSOLIDATED PLAN 2009 ONE-YEAR ACTION PLAN

### PROPOSED 2009 CDBG PROGRAM CHANGES

#### Decrease Funding

1. **City of Camas Goot Park Improvements.** A series of improvements for Goot Park, including an ADA compliant and centrally located bathroom facility, off-street parking, sidewalks, safe play structures and paths to link facilities together. This project will be provided a pre-award, which will have no effect on recipient's eligibility for future grants. CDBG Budget: \$258,000 from ARRA funds. Decrease funding by \$60,000.

#### Increase Funding

2. **Camas Community Center Mobility Improvements.** A series of improvements to the Community Center at 1718 SE 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Camas to improve accessibility. Deck space, motorized doors and an additional exit will be added for improved access and safety. CDBG Budget: \$50,000 from reprogrammed funds. Increase funding by \$60,000 of ARRA funds.
