## WHAT IS CAM?



In 2009, the Clark County Family Treatment Court applied for and received funding for a grant through

the U.S. Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration (SAMHSA). The grant program is aimed to treat children and families affected by methamphetamine use. The CAM grant (Children Affected by Methamphetamine) couples the existing Family Treatment Court team with community providers Children's Center and Children's Home Society to provide individualized services for Children that have been impacted by family Methamphetamine use, their care takers and the birth parents.

The program utilizes neuro-psych testing to find and address areas of need for the children and the birthparent, then providing hands-on evidenced based services to the children and parents with the hope of reconciling the family, and treating the impact of methamphetamine use for the long term. This grant is a four year grant that runs through September 30, 2014.

## HOW IT WORKS

### Family Recovery

While you get help, we work with your child so they get to recover also. Then we help you and your child reconnect so you



have real family recovery.

### Child Therapy

We work with your child to get a personal

recovery roadmap for them.

### Family Therapy

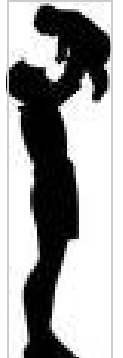

## WHO IS CAM FOR?

CAM is for children who have been affected by their parent's methamphetamine use. Children of meth abuse need the same chance to recover as their parents and to heal from effects of a parent's drug use and have family recovery.

CAM is for parents who have used meth and are wanting extra support in their treatment and rebuilding their family; and foster parents of children whose parent (s) have used meth.



CAM is for foster parents to help them recognize and ease a child's symptoms of exposure to parental meth use. Early treatment makes a difference when it is time to reconnect with their parents in early recovery.
