It's easy because there's only 10 questions per person. The form has a section for each person in a household, and it's important to include children.

It's safe because by law, all the information is confidential. Not even the President can see it.

It counts because each person counted in our area means \$1,032 for Clark County every year for the next ten years. This money funds numerous programs that you care about. The data is used to draw school district boundaries, determine congressional representation and make funding decisions for Title 1 grants, Head Start, WIC, public transportation, road construction and emergency food and shelter services.

By completing your U.S. Census questionnaire, you can directly affect the quality of life in your community. Please help Clark County receive the funds it requires to provide the services we depend on. Take the time to return your form.

Be counted and make a difference in the future of Clark County!
